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STAKEHOLDER CARD

### **Goals:**

You are attending this meeting in order to promote culture in your community. Your main priorities are:

- To promote culture, arts, music and sports, and make the community a fun place to live
- To create spaces for artists to express themselves and sell their art
- To highlight the community's history and raise awareness on the contributions of different groups."

### **Common Good:**

You are also an ordinary citizen with a lot of different interests. You want to help make this a good development for the city in all kinds of ways — not just for culture and recreation. As a local resident, you stand to benefit if the community is thriving as a whole.

## QUICK-PLAY GUIDE

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### 1 - Stakeholder Meeting:

- Meet with the players in your class who picked the same stakeholder card as you.
- Discuss your stakeholder group's priorities. Skim the list of cards and identify ones you think are especially important for your stakeholder group.

### 2 - Priority Setting:

- Return to your committee and distribute the Feature Cards.
- Independently sort the cards in your hand based on your priorities. Put cards you think should be included in the proposal in a "Yes" pile and those you don't think should be included in a "No" pile.
- Each player takes a turn sharing the cards in their "No" pile with the rest of the committee. If a player reveals a card you would like to see included in the Final Proposal, pick it up and place it in your "Yes" pile. If everyone thinks a card should not be included, discard it.

### 3 - Deliberations:

- Each player takes a turn presenting their "Yes" cards. If everyone agrees a card should be included in the Final Proposal, place it in the "Proposal" pile on the board. If not everyone is in agreement, place it in the "Maybe Include" pile on the board.
- Deliberate with your committee until there is consensus on which 16 cards to include in the "Proposal" pile. Don't forget to use your Flex Cards.

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## MEMBER OF ALL FOR ONE (AFO)
