	Beach A beach in the town center where people can relax, and vendors can sell food and goods.		Bike Lanes Fully separated bike lanes on major streets to ensure cyclists can ride around safely.
	Boardwalk An elevated waterfront boardwalk where visitors can walk, shop, and enjoy the scenery without harming the environment.		Co-op Townhouses Cooperatively owned townhouses that make single-family homes more affordable.
	Community Garden A public garden where people can grow food and enjoy gardening.		Coworking Space A shared space where individuals can work, reducing time commuting or the cost of office rent.
	Daycare and Preschool A daycare and preschool centre where parents can easily drop off their kids on their way to work.		Farmer's Market A covered area allowing for a year round farmer's market in the community.
	Food Bank A place where people can donate food and goods for those in need to pick up.		Food Forest Streets and green areas lined with fruit trees and shrubs that provide people with accessible food.
	Hockey Arena An arena which can host recreational teams and provide space for people to skate.		Indigenous Cultural Center A complex offering services to Indigenous people and educating locals about their heritage.
	Industrial Park An area of town that houses a number of factories and warehouses for local businesses.		Local History Exhibits Outdoor displays and plaques meant to highlight local history.
	Luxury Condos Lavish midrise with many expensive units for wealthier people.		Mixed-Use Buildings Medium-rise buildings with businesses on the bottom and homes above.
	Newcomers Centre A resource centre offering free language and job skills classes for new immigrants.		Outdoor Entertainment Venue A large grass area with a small stage for outdoor concerts and festivals.
	Petting Zoo A hands-on area where visitors can interact with friendly animals for a fee.		Playground with Splash Pad A playground with slides, climbing equipment, and a splash pad with sprinklers
	Restaurants and Ice Cream Shops An area with restaurants and ice cream shops, perfect for families and couples.		Science Centre A space with interactive science exhibits and hands-on activities.
	Seniors Centre A centre where seniors can meet and participate in social and recreational activities		Sharing Depot A place where people can borrow tools and equipment that they do not own.
	Shops A space for local artists to sell handmade goods.		Studio Space A space for artists and musicians to rehearse, create, and teach others.
	Tiny Forest Repurposed urban spaces with hundreds of trees and plants to improve air quality and reduce summer heat.		Transit Hub A location with parking, bus stops, and train stops to facilitate commuting.
	Tree Canopies A tree canopy over most streets to improve air quality, reduce heat, and beautify the area.		Youth Drop-In Centre A centre that provides services and programming for youth.
