Intended Outcome(s) or Goal(s):

Encourage participants to consider different perspectives on the use of AI in education, reflect on its benefits and risks, and practice respectful discussion on a controversial issue.

Anticipated Challenges		
Potential Challenge	Response or Strategy	
Some arguing too emotionally or aggressively	Reinforce the discussion guidelines, refer to PLANS	
Participants go off-topic	Refocus with the core question	
Participants refuse to listen to different perspectives	Encourage participants to identify shared values or experiences to facilitate discussion	

Flow of the discussion		
Introduction / Hook	 Ask participants to share their experiences related to Al. Example questions: What was the last time you used an Al tool? Can you share a time you used an Al tool that was helpful for you? Can you share a time you use an Al tool that did not help you? Present the discussion prompt and follow with a quick anonymous poll Al in schools is: mostly good; mostly bad; somewhere in between; unsure. 	
	Key question(s):	
Main exchange	 What are some of the major ways that AI can be used in education? What are some reasons for and against allowing AI in school? 	
	Discussion Protocol: Think-Pair-Share	
	 Think: Participants think independently and write down 2 reasons for and 2 against AI in school. Pair: Participants pair up and exchange and compare their points. Share: After participants have shared with their partners, expand the sharing into a whole group discussion. 	
Conclusion / Debrief	 Reiterate the goal of the discussion: to consider different perspectives on the use of AI in education, reflect on its benefits and risks, and practice respectful dialogue on a controversial issue. Repeat the discussion prompt and follow with an anonymous poll: Has your opinion changed since the beginning of the discussion? What is one concern you still have after this discussion? What is one benefit of AI in education that you hadn't thought about before?
